Remember, the Chapter Mileage Program is different from the Ride 365 program and in addition to that program through Harley-Davidson. To sign up for your Ride 365 mileage program, you can see one of our Road Captains on any ride in January. They will have a signup sheet similar to what you can give Leslie at the Dealership. To sign up, you'll need your HOG number, last 6 of your VIN and your mileage to start the year. This should be easy since you'll have your bike there with you when you come to a ride! Your 365 miles may also earn you awards and gift cards from Harley. So, sign up at the start of the year!

The Road Captains have already started planning rides for 2024. We'll experience some of the same great rides and support some of the same great causes, like the Maci's Ride for Autism and The Pink Ride for Breast Cancer. Riding a motorcycle during the holidays can be a great experience, but it's important to take extra precautions due to increased traffic and weather hazards. Here are some tips for motorcycle riding during the Winter:

- 1. Check the weather: Before heading out, be sure to check the weather forecast for your route. Winter weather can be unpredictable, so it's important to be prepared for any and all conditions.
- 2. Dress for the weather: If you're riding in cold weather, make sure to dress in layers and wear thermal or insulated gear to stay warm. Heated gear is a good thing to have.
- 3. Plan your route: Holiday traffic and road conditions can be crazy and heavy, so plan your route carefully to avoid any problems. GPS is good to have.
- 4. Stay visible: Days are shorter during the winter, so make sure your motorcycle lights all work and having reflectors are a bonus. I put reflective tape on my helmet too.
- 5. Take breaks: Riding in cold weather can be physically demanding, so be sure to take regular breaks to warm up and stay alert and hydrated.
- 6.Don't drink and ride: Holiday celebrations often involve alcohol, so be extra cautious and never ride your motorcycle if you've been drinking.

It all comes down to using common sense especially this time of year with heavy traffic and bad weather. Enjoy and ride safe.
